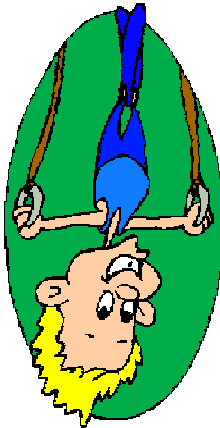

HERE'S TO A GREAT SUMMER!

Dear Parents,

First and foremost, please know that we consider it the highest form of compliment that you are entrusting your child to our care. We are looking forward to a fantastic summer with your child! We are confident that this will be an awesome summer of physical fitness, confidence building, friendship, and of course gymnastics for your child. We would like to take this opportunity to tell you just a little about our activities this summer.

Our seasoned staff is dedicated to making your child's summer something out of the ordinary in our state of the art 27,000 sq. ft. facility! We have chosen a theme for each week of camp offered this summer and each activity your child participates in will be geared around that theme - everything from group games to arts and crafts, food prep for special snacks, and field trips. The specific themes for the summer are listed on the "Theme Week" page included in this packet. Encourage your child to participate in all of the activities as it makes for a wonderfully festive atmosphere for everyone. We are pleased to offer various field trips weekly throughout the summer! Our awesome field trips include the Central Florida Zoo, Orlando Science Center, Kid Tropolis, Celebrity Mascot Games at the Amway Center, Semoran Skateway, Longwood Lanes Bowling, AmStar Cinemas Lake Mary; and for the first time in ACE Summer Camp field trip history, we will be going to SEA WORLD!!! **The Sea World field trip will cost \$15 per child** in addition to the weekly camp fees unless proof of annual pass or Fun Pass is presented to ACE upon payment of camp fees. In addition to these amazing trips, **WE WILL GO SWIMMING EVERY FRIDAY** morning at Lyman High School (weather permitting), followed by lunch at Greenwood Lakes Park. Please note the following exceptions: **Week 8 we will go swimming on Thursday** instead to allow for the Celebrity Mascot Games field trip on Friday and there will be **NO swimming trip during Week 9** in order for the ACE Olympics performance to take place on Friday at the gym. Be sure to bring a swimsuit, towel, and pack your camper a lunch each swim trip as they will be off-site and snack bar lunch purchases will not be an option on this day. See the "Theme Weeks" page for more information on scheduled field trips and drop-off times for the campers to ensure they arrive prior to departure.

In keeping with the ACE summer camp tradition, we are excited to once again host our very own ACE Olympics during Week 9! Our version of the highly anticipated Summer Olympics will be held on Friday, August 5th (THERE WILL BE NO SWIMMING FIELD TRIP THIS FRIDAY). The week will be filled with activities in preparation for Friday's big event as the campers learn their routines and are divided into groups representing different countries. Each country/group will march in and then compete in each gymnastic event. Medals will be awarded to all participants at the end of the competition in an Olympic style award ceremony. Bring your cameras and camcorders and capture some terrific memory-making moments! We will reward all of our talented athletes with a pizza party afterwards.

*Field Trips are subject to changes or cancellations at ACE Gymnastic's discretion. In addition to the weekly trips posted on previous page, WE WILL GO SWIMMING EVERY FRIDAY at Lyman High School at 10:00 a.m. (weather permitting), followed by picnic lunch at Greenwood Lakes Park. Please make note of the following exceptions: Week 8 we will swim on THURSDAY and Week 9 there will be NO swimming trip. PROGRAM FEES / CAMP DETAILS

REGISTRATION FEE: \$10.00 (applies only if not a registered member at ACE for '10-'11)

PROGRAM FEES:

- ⚙ 5 full days - \$160.00 (8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.*)
\$20 off Sibling Discount applies to 5-full day campers only
- ⚙ 3 days - \$115.00 (Mon., Wed., Fri. – No Substitutions)
- ⚙ 2 days - \$85.00 (Tues. & Thurs. – No Substitutions)
- ⚙ Early Drop Off / 7:30-8:30 am – \$5.00 per day per family / \$15 max weekly fee
- ⚙ \$45.00 daily Drop-in rate applies without advance reservations. Drop-ins on a field trip day will include an additional cost for trip. Fee will vary based on particular field trip costs.
- ⚙ All field trips are included in camp prices EXCEPT for Sea World / Week 3. Cost for Sea World field trip is an extra \$15 per child unless you are an annual member or fun pass holder (please present pass to ACE at time of registration.)



*Please note that if you arrive later than 6:00 p.m. to pick up your child there will be a strictly enforced \$10.00 charge for every 15 minutes past 6:00 p.m. until pick up time.

CAMP DETAILS:

- ⚙ ACE summer camp welcomes children ages 5-12. Preschool camp is available for ages 3-4 (see "2011 Preschool Summer Day Camp" packet for details.)
- ⚙ NO half day hours/rates offered to school-aged children, K-12.
- ⚙ Your child will receive an ACE Summer Day Camp Tee Shirt to be worn on all field trips.
- ⚙ Lunch & snacks will not be provided; however, you may open a pre-paid snack account for your child to purchase food at our snack bar. Lunch will not be served at the snack bar on Fridays during swimming field trips. Please pack a picnic style bag lunch for your child to bring on swimming trips and other specific field trips as noted on "Theme Weeks" page.

CHECK IN AND OUT PROCEDURES

It is required that your child be **SIGNED IN & OUT each day**. In the morning, please sign your child in at the front desk. Your child may then enter the gym and join their group (the daily Sign-In sheet will indicate what group they are in). When picking up your child we ask that you go upstairs to sign your child out with a day camp counselor.

If another adult other than a parent or legal guardian is picking up, we require that they be an authorized person listed on your child's registration form. Any deviation from routine pickup or persons not listed on the registration form (i.e., a visiting relative, friend, etc.) must be indicated in writing by the parent or legal guardian and given to administrative staff at the front desk so that we can communicate this to the appropriate day camp counselor. **ANYONE PICKING UP YOUR CHILD MUST KNOW THE PASSWORD YOU DESIGNATED ON THE REGISTRATION FORM.** Your cooperation concerning this procedure will help ensure the safety of your child.

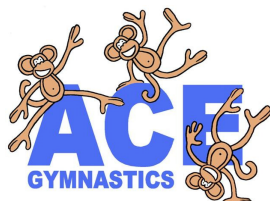
PAYMENT POLICIES / TERMS

The camp fees listed on the previous page are for advance reservations. In order to take advantage of these rates, we require a **5 business day notice**. If this is not received, a Drop-in fee of \$45 per day will be charged. **If you drop-in on a field trip day, there will be an additional charge for the trip.**

You may transfer reserved weeks if we are given a **5 business day notice** and based on availability. If we are not notified one full week in advance, you will be charged for your reservation.

If you are reserving two weeks of camp or less, payment for all reserved dates are due upon registration. If you are reserving more than two weeks, we require payment in advance for your first week at registration in addition to a one week deposit to be held as payment for your last week's attendance at camp. The deposit collected is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and **MUST** be applied toward your final weeks' reservation. If you choose not to have your child attend the last week YOU reserved and designated as their final week of camp on your registration form, **YOUR DEPOSIT WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.**

All reservations over two weeks will REQUIRE a Guaranteed Form of Payment to be kept on file in the form of a credit card. Your credit card will always be charged on the Thursday prior to your subsequent week's reservation. If you wish to pay by check or cash, payment must be received by the Wednesday preceding your reservation or your credit card will be charged. ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE and NO REFUNDS will be given for missed days/weeks or cancellations. ACE accepts Visa and MasterCard.



Don't forget to find a Fall Gymnastics or Tumbling class at the end of summer so you can keep in touch with your ACE buds all year long! Registration begins in July and Fall classes start in August. ACE also has an awesome After School Care Program that picks up from Bentley, Choices in Learning, Crystal Lake, Heathrow, Idyllwilde, Lake Mary, Longwood, Wilson & Woodlands.
